## Plug-in settings

Go to **Admin > Extensions > My extensions > H1 Variants on product detail**.

Here you can set-up which columns you want to show in the variant list of the product detail page. You can even change the sorting.


## Add variants list in product detail page

Go to **Admin > Content > Shopping Experiences > tab "Product page"**.

You will notice that the "Default Product Page Layout" cannot be edited (see the lock icon in the bottom-right corner). Therefore, we will duplicate this layout, allowing us to add the variant list block later.


Click on the "..." icon of the layout you want to duplicate, for example "Default product page Layout", and click on "Duplicate".

Now you can adjust the duplicated layout.



In the new layout, add the **"H1 Product Variants"** block.

Go to the plus icon, select **"Commerce"** in the Block category, and then drag the "H1 Product Variants" block into the layout.



Finally, ensure that all products are assigned to the new default layout.

Go to the **layout assignment** icon and click on **“Set as default layout”**.

**Note:** this only works if the products are not assigned to a different layout.



## Create variants in Shopware


This is a default feature of Shopware.

Go to **Admin > Catalogues > Properties** to add variants based, for example, on color or size.



Go to **Admin > Catalogues > Products > select a product > tab "Variants"**.

Click on "Generate variants" to select properties and to generate the variants.



Ultimately, the product page with the variant list will be displayed on the storefront.
